We need two full-time, qualified teachers to join our team serving the poor by teaching in the local community. Applicants must be prepared to support the Christian ethos of the school. These positions are for Foundation Phase/Key Stage 1 and Intermediate Phase/Key Stage 2, teaching children aged approximately 5 - 8 years or 8 - 13 years, respectively.
These are volunteer posts for international teachers or paid employment for a SA resident and require a minimum 2 year commitment. We are a low fee paying school so applicants from SA should be aware that pay will not be comparable with a government school position.
A volunteer visa to South Africa will be required for international applicants, accompanied by a university transcript of the qualification course studied and a qualification certificate/s.
All teachers at the school are required to be registered with the South African Council of Educators (SACE).

Dihlabeng Christian School is situated in the town of Clarens, Eastern Free State, South Africa (3½ hours south of Johannesburg). This is a beautiful town, frequented by tourists, yet there are many residents living in poverty and need.

Dihlabeng Christian School was started in January 2000 as a part of Dihlabeng Christian Church's desire to bring hope to the hopeless by working with the materially disadvantaged and those from the poorer parts of the Clarens' community.

The school is based on the verse from Isaiah 32:2, which paraphrased says: "The school - will be like a shelter from the wind and a refuge from the storm and like streams of water in the desert; the shadow of a great rock in a thirsty land." In short we are offering hope to the hopeless so that they in turn can become hope givers.
